EVENT GUIDELINES

Below are examples of both accepted and not accepted items by our event partners. Please note, this is not a comprehensive list, but a general guideline.

Accepted Items	Items NOT Accepted
Small appliances	Light bulbs
Computers & Laptops	Ion batteries
VCRs	Rechargeable batteries
Printers	Old-style cathode ray tube (CRT) TVs
Household batteries	Chemicals
Phones	Anything that has not been properly drained
Cell phones	Furniture
Metal items	Hazardous household waste
Miscellaneous wires	Propane tanks
	Fire extinguishers
	Car batteries
	<i>Paper and sensitive documents</i>
